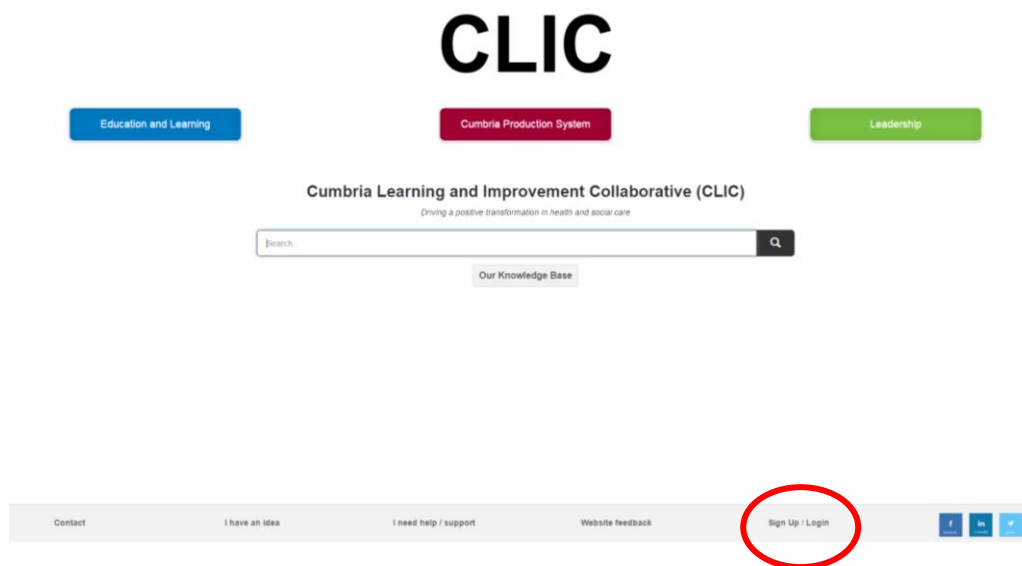

The **CLIC Clinical Nursing Skills Programme (Forerunner Fund Project)** is the result of a successful bid for funding from Health Education North West to deliver an exciting new, collaborative approach to education and learning across Cumbria. It represents a different approach to education and training by working collaboratively and co-operatively with partners across health and social care in Cumbria and the University of Cumbria to build trust and communication across nursing teams, improve networks and opportunities for learning, develop common core nursing skills and improve the quality of patient care.

This Clinical Skills Programme is aimed at qualified nurses in acute and community hospitals, GP practices, care homes and community nursing, and will provide a high quality training programme in six core clinical skills areas across Cumbria. The skills programme will be delivered close to clinicians' places of work and be supported by Clinical Skills Educators (newly appointed and who will become Associates of the University of Cumbria) to embed core skills into practice with clinicians across organisation boundaries providing a common approach to delivering clinical skills training.


